





On October 6, 2016 starting at 4:30 p.m., UPSTART, a street party designed to inspire the entrepreneur in all of us will take place in Covington for the fourth year in a row. This year the event will be held at 632 Russell St. Covington, KY in the alley between Washington Avenue and Russell Street.

Have you ever wondered where all those people walking down Main Street during the World Chicken Festival come from? Saturday evening Alice and I conducted a very unscientific poll. I would stop people at random and ask them if they minded telling me where they were from. Alice did the same thing while selling t-shirts at the Chamber booth.

Combined we polled 225 people. 46 (20%) were from Laurel County. 100 (44%) were from other counties in Kentucky. 66 (29%) were from 14 other states. The furthest away being Washington, Idaho and Montana. 13 (6%) were from outside the United States. I met a couple from Belgium, a lady from Belize, and Alice met a group of 10 from Canada that come every year.

I know this is a small sample and is very unscientific, but I think it still gives us an idea of how wide-spread of an area our visitors come from.

One of the more interesting couples Alice talked with was a man from Idaho and a lady from Montana that were backpacking across America.




