CLG Communities: Federal regulations require that local historic district commissions in communities participating in the Certified Local Government Program (CLG) be notified 60 days in advance if a property in their community is being presented to the Kentucky State Review Board for consideration of listing in the National Register of Historic Places.

*The CLG communities in Kentucky are: Anchorage, Bardstown, Bellevue, Boone County, Bowling Green, Campbellsville, Covington, Danville, Dawson Springs, Frankfort, Hopkinsville, Horse Cave, Louisville-Jefferson County Metro Government, La Grange, Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, Maysville, Middlesboro, Middletown, Newport, Owensboro, Paducah, Pikeville, Shelbyville
