What Does the Public Access Kiosk Do?

The public can access [KHC's E-Library](#) and [Geographic Information System \(GIS\)](#).

GIS: The *GIS* is one of the ways that KHC maintains the vast inventory of historically significant resources. The GIS map displays the locations of surveyed sites as well as multiple layers that can be hidden or made visible depending on the user's preferences.

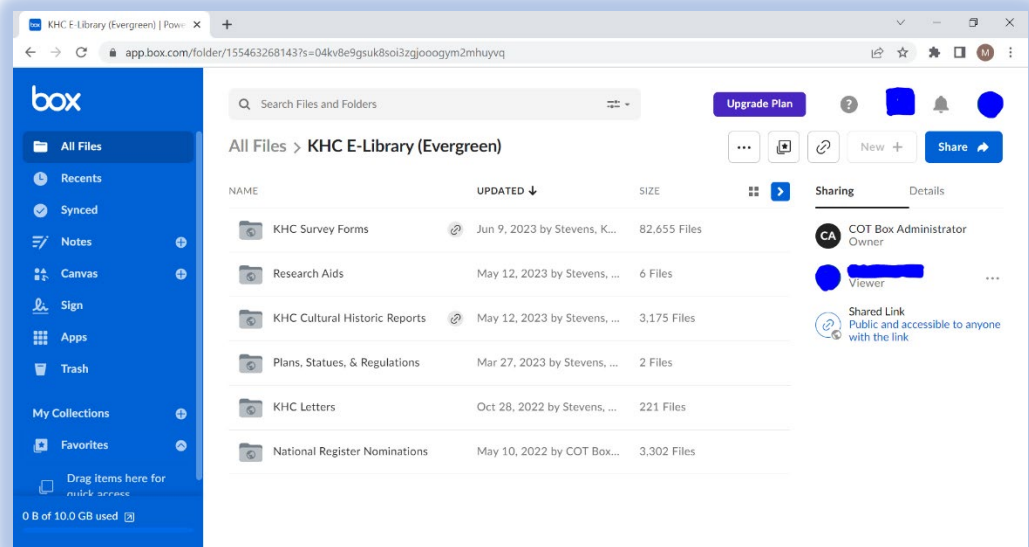
E-Library: The *E-Library* contains documents like historic survey forms, cultural-historic reports, National Register Nomination Forms among other useful sources.

What Can I Use This Information For?

Site Checks: The information from our GIS can help determine for a project area, which properties have been surveyed, which of those surveyed need to be resurveyed and those that have not been surveyed and need a KHC Inventory Number Assignment. These are called "Site-Checks" and can help in planning survey and documentation efforts.

Background Research: The GIS accompanied with Cultural-Historic Reports and Survey Forms can fill in background information. Historic information on the counties and communities where a project is planned can be gleaned from the work of previous investigations as well as information on individual properties themselves.

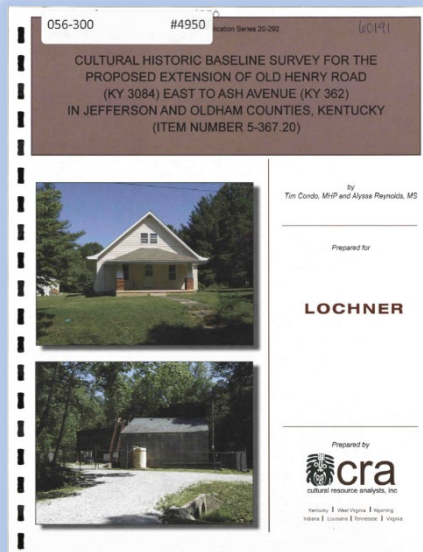
KHC's E-Library: KHC has an account with Box where our E-Library is stored. Within the E-Library are folders containing survey forms, National Register Nominations and Cultural-Historic Reports is some of the sources that KHC has to offer. Feel free to click on the folders and explore the contents.



What Are the Various Types of Sources?

Survey Forms: Offer a broad a quick glance information about a resource's building materials, architectural description and its history.

Cultural Historic Reports: Are in most cases, reports generated by cultural resource management firms. Contained therein are project descriptions, summarized county histories, architectural descriptions, historic information on historically significant properties, maps, etc.

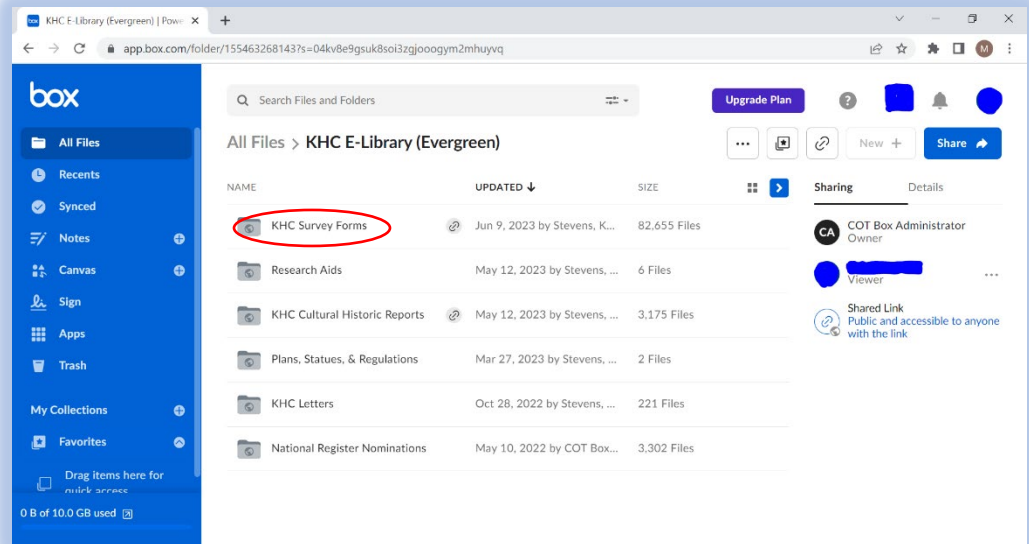
KHC's Transmittal Letters: Transmittal letters capture KHC's official comments and responses and serve as a useful tool in capturing KHC's National Register eligibility designations.

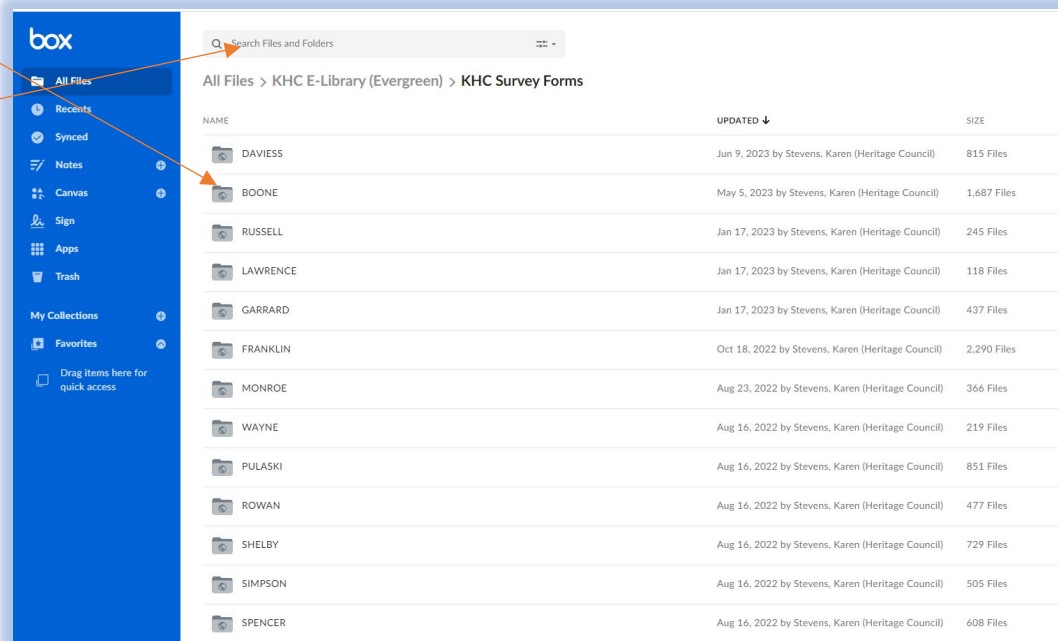
Searching KHC's E-Library

Searching for Survey Forms: KHC's survey forms are organized by county.

1. Using the mouse, select the folder "KHC Survey Forms"




2. Scroll through the list of counties or type the desired county in the search bar and then open the county's folder.

3. Once inside the desired county folder, type in the resource number (ex. *BE 855*) into the search bar, press enter and the desired survey form should pop right up. Click on the desired file and a PDF file of your selected survey form will open.

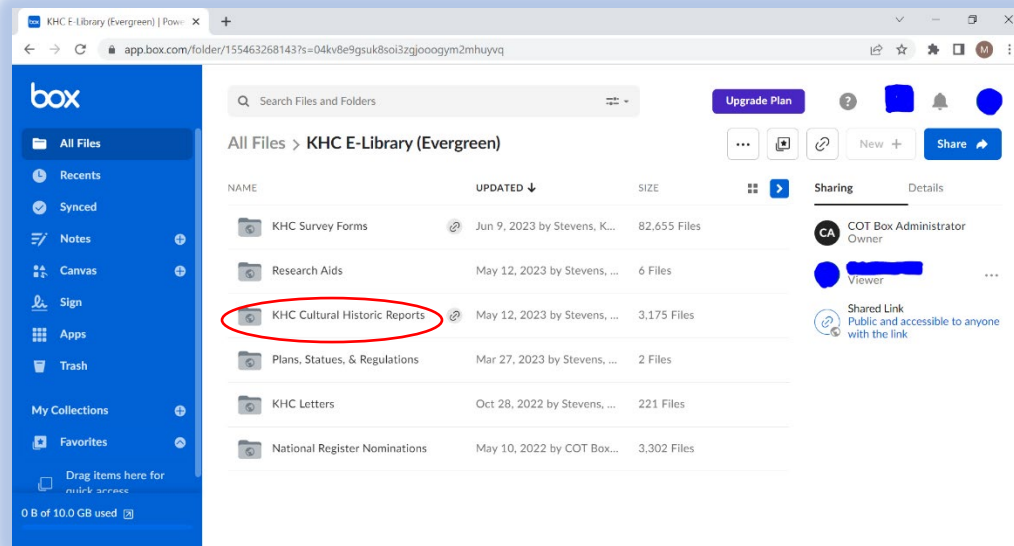

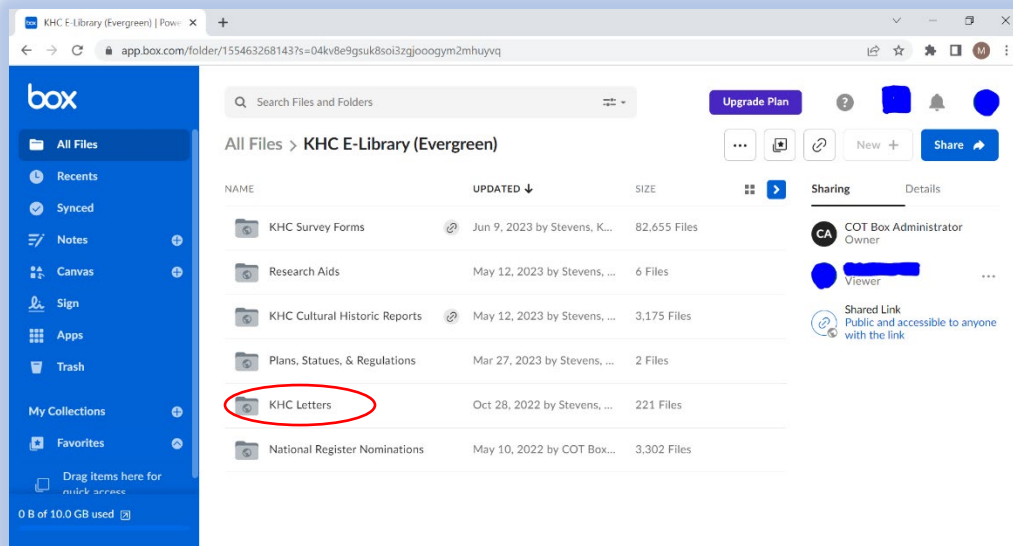

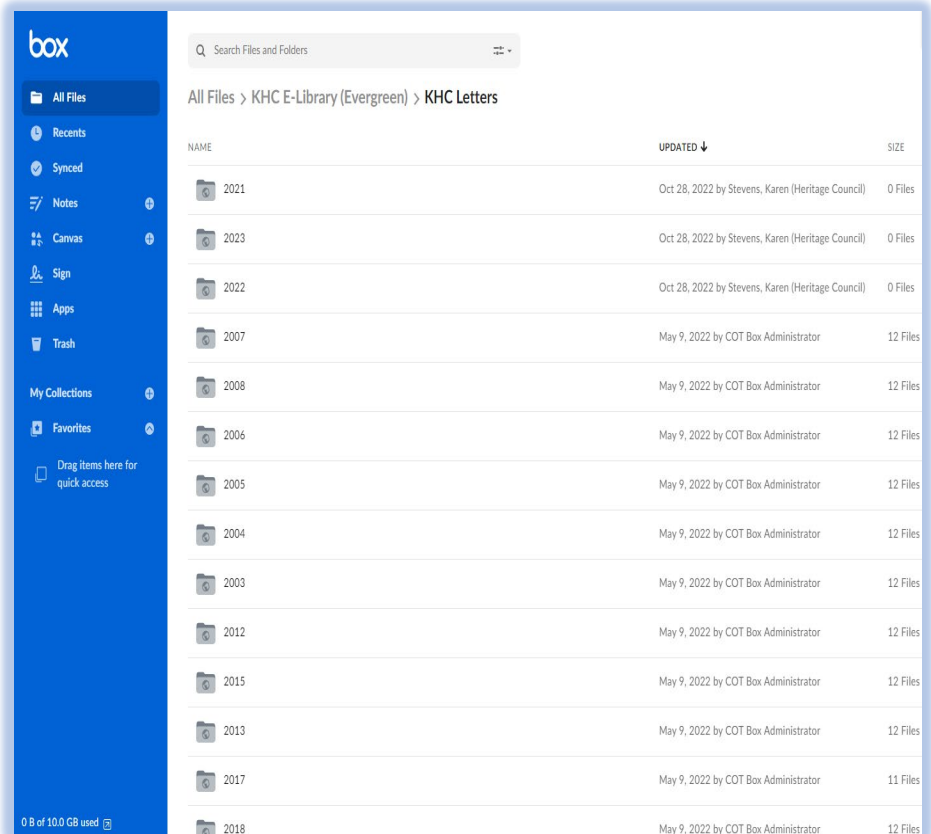

Searching KHC's Transmittal Letters

1. Use the mouse to open the folder "KHC Letters".



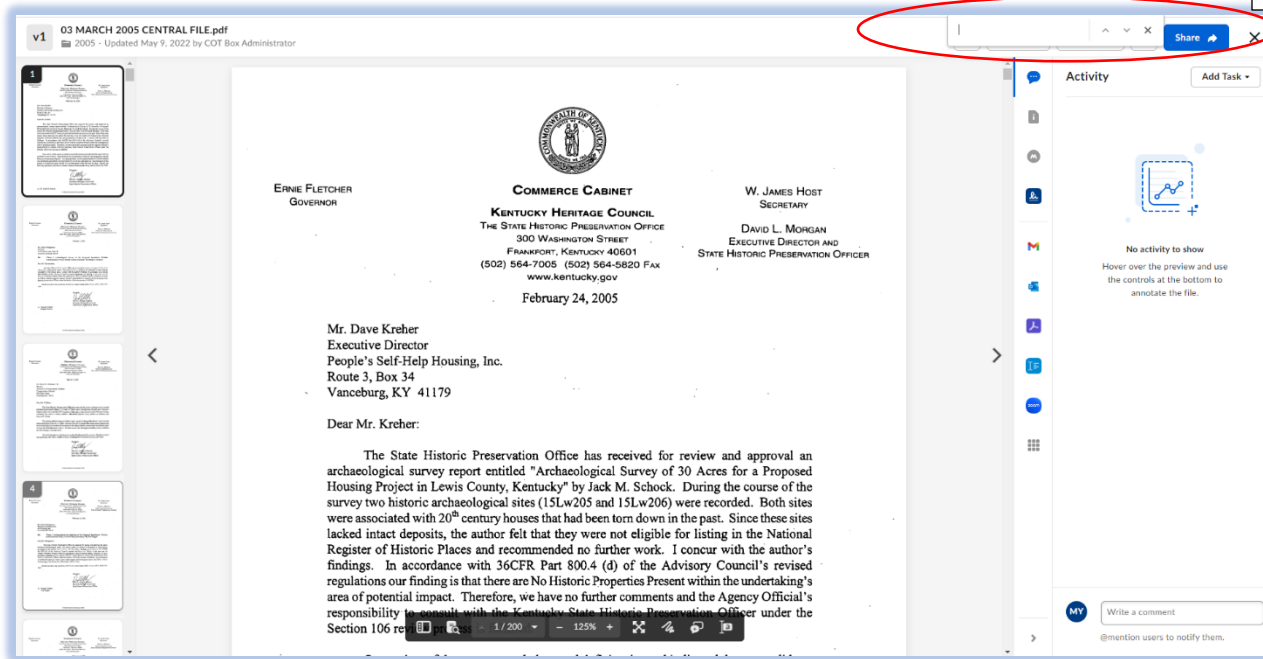
2. The folders are organized by *years* that KHC's letters were issued. If you need help determining the year reach out to the survey coordinator. Once the year has been determined, click on the desired year's folder.



3. you can conduct a “key word” search of the PDF documents by pressing “Ctrl + F”. Once the search bar has opened, try searching for you document by “County”, “Project Number”, “Project Name” or any other unique identifier which may be picked up from a key-word search.
