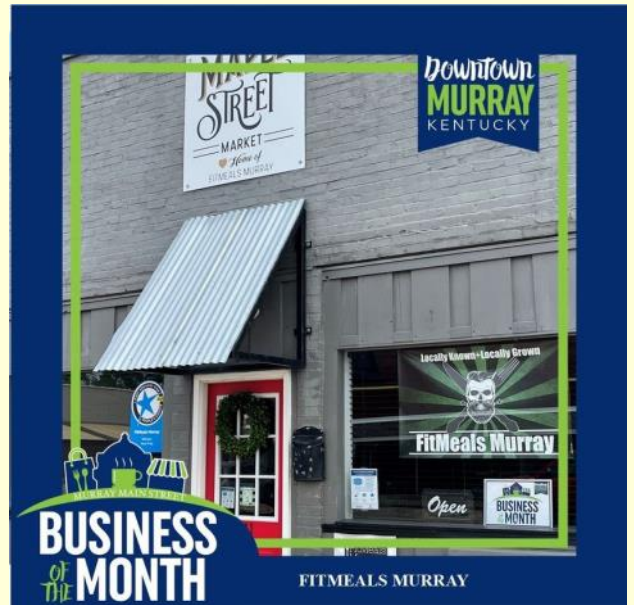

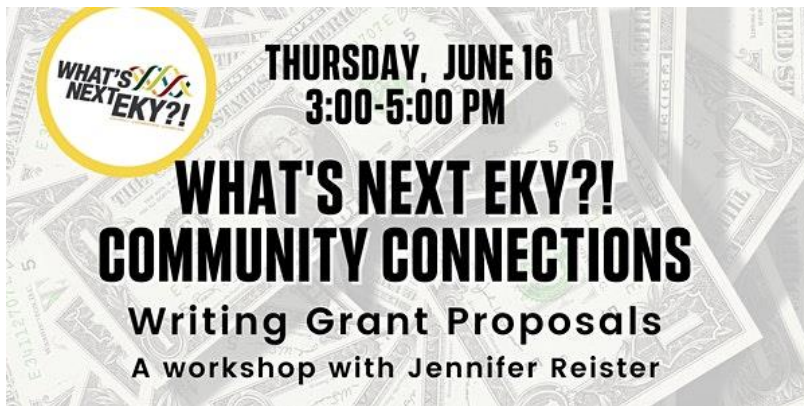

- Fall: Applications open July – September
- Winter: Applications open October – December
