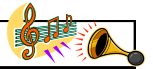
Another way to tell your story is with oral history grants. Mercer County (Harrodsburg) has created two books, the Men of Mercer County and the Women of Mercer County.

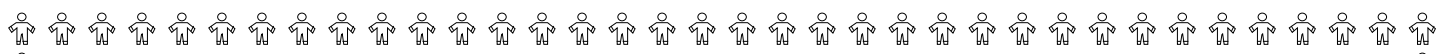


I AM DOWNTOWN

Subject: Benton Main Street

We are sponsoring a campaign called FACES of Marshall County. It is a public art project that will benefit the new Marshall County Arts Center that is being built in our downtown on what was a vacant lot (whoot whoot!!).

Here is a quick rundown of how it works...we are collecting photographs of anyone or anything (we prefer to take the photos so we can get a good quality). The "early bird" special is \$35. That gets one head shot taken. The picture will be printed to be 3ft x 2ft in black/white. The photos will be displayed all over the county in business windows from June 15-July 15. Then each person gets to take their picture home. We are using a fundraising website called Indiegogo. To visit our site and see the promo video, go to bentonmainstreet.com and click on the link. The Indiegogo site keeps up with the money raised and the days left on the campaign. It also posts the names of people that have contributed. We have "perk packages" available for those want to donate more than \$35. Those include tickets and recognition to the new Arts Center events. The money raised will build the covered canopy for the arts center. The official name of the project is "We are Marshall County and we 'cover' our kids!" Our Rotary Club donated \$12,500 to the project this week!!!

We are very fortunate to have an Economic Committee chair that was a founding member of Downtown Nashville. This was done in Nashville last month so are getting to mimic their project.

We will be having a reveal party on the court square on June 15 to kick off the "search for your FACE" because we aren't telling where we put you!
