HRSA (Healthcare)	Building + adjacent buildings
Park Improvements	0.5 mile
Buried lines with above ground components	1 mile
Solar Farms, new construction <sup>1</sup>	1 mile
Roadwork, County or State level	500 feet
Rooftop or small commercial solar, new	500 feet
Sidewalk installation	500 feet
Substation	0.5 miles
Trails	500 feet
Transmission Lines	0.5 miles

- Building Acquisition Only (no additional construction activities)
- Building Mortgages/Refinancing
- HUD/CDBG-CV Utility Forgiveness Projects
- Divestment of Building(s), Property from Federal Ownership
- Any projects that have no above ground elements
- Any projects that the landscape will remain unchanged after project completion
- Projects within abandoned mine lands

If your Section 106 project description does not fit within parameters listed above, you may provide the results of a site check for one mile from the centerpoint or centerline of your project area for consideration with the remainder of your Section 106 documentation.
